


Q1 How would you rate the organization of the LRC Summer Sports program? (Baseball, Softball, T-Ball & Coach Pitch)





Q4 Youth Teams Only: How would you rate your child's coach during games and practices?



Q5 Youth Teams Only: Practice sessions served a useful purpose in preparing the children for games.


